The Law



Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh. (Genesis 2:24)

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Non-separation Clause

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one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate."



Lifetime Clause

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- Romans 7:2 For a married woman is bound by law to her husband while he lives, but if her husband dies she is released from the law of marriage.
- Romans 7:3 Accordingly, she will be called an adulteress if she lives with another man while her husband is alive. But if her husband dies, she is free from that law, and if she marries another man she is not an adulteress.



Exception Clause



- Matthew 19:9 And I say to you: whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality [fornication], and marries another, commits adultery."
- Matthew 5:32 But I say to you that everyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of sexual immorality [fornication], makes her commit adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery.



Exception Clause

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CROnly One Exception to the Rule

Except for fornication

[adultery, homosexuality, lesbianism, bestiality, pedophilia, necrophilia, prostitution]

Pharisees' Question to Jesus

Matthew 19:3 And Pharisees came up to him and tested him by asking, "Is it lawful to divorce one's wife for any cause?"



Jesus' Response

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read that he who created them from the beginning made them male and female,

Matthew 19:5 and said, 'Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'?

Jesus' Response

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Matthew 19:6 So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate."



Pharisees' Follow-up Question

Matthew 19:7 They said to him, "Why then did Moses command one to give a certificate of divorce and to send her away?"



Jesus' Final Reply

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Matthew 19:8 He said to them, "Because of your hardness of heart Moses allowed you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so.

Matthew 19:9 And I say to you: whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality [fornication], and marries another, commits adultery."

Jewish Interpretations

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Two leading Jewish (Pharisaic) schools of thought.

Matthew 19:3 The Pharisees also came unto him, tempting him, and saying unto him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for every cause or [for any reason]?



Jewish Schools of Thought

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- The House of Shammai say, "A man should divorce his wife only because he has found grounds for it in unchastity, "since it is said, Because he has found in her indecency in anything (Dt. 24:1)
- And the **House of Hillel** say, "Even if she spoiled his dish, "since it is said, Because he has found in her **indecency** in anything."
- R. Aqiba says, "Even if he found someone else prettier than she, "since it is said, And it shall be if she find no favor in his eyes (Dt. 24:1)."

School of Shammai

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- The House of Shammai say, "A man should divorce his wife only because he has found grounds for it in unchastity, "since it is said, Because he has found in her indecency in anything (Dt. 24:1)
- Deuteronomy 24:1 "When a man takes a wife and marries her, if then she finds no favor in his eyes because he has found some indecency in her, and he writes her a certificate of divorce and puts it in her hand and sends her out of his house, and she departs out of his house,

School of Hillel



- And the **House of Hillel** say, "Even if she spoiled his dish, "since it is said, Because he has found in her indecency in anything."
- Deuteronomy 24:1 "When a man takes a wife and marries her, if then she finds no favor in his eyes because he has found some indecency in her, and he writes her a certificate of divorce and puts it in her hand and sends her out of his house, and she departs out of his house,

Interpretation of "Indecency"

- The debate was concerning what "indecency" meant.
- School of Shammai (ca. 50 BC 20 AD): unchastity
- any reason (e.g., even if she ruined his food)
 - Rabbi Aqiba (ca. 50 AD ca. 135 AD) (of the school of Hillel): even if he found someone else more attractive

Remain Unmarried or Be Reconciled

Corinthians 7:10 To the married I give this charge (not I, but the Lord): the wife should not separate from her husband

CR1 Corinthians 7:11 (but if she does, she should remain unmarried or else be reconciled to her husband), and the husband should not divorce his wife.

Pauline Privilege?

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Cal Corinthians 7:12 To the rest I say (I, not the Lord) that if any brother has a wife who is an unbeliever, and she consents to live with him, let him not send her away.

Cal Corinthians 7:13 If any woman has a husband who is an unbeliever, and he consents to live with her, let her not send him away.

Pauline Privilege?

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husband is made holy because of his wife, and the unbelieving wife is made holy because of her husband. Otherwise your children would be unclean, but as it is, they are holy.



Pauline Privilege?

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Corinthians 7:15 But if the unbelieving partner separates, let it be so. In such cases the brother or sister is not enslaved. God has called you to peace.

Singleness (Remaining Unmarried)

- Matthew 19:10 The disciples said to him, "If such is the case of a man with his wife, it is better not to marry."
- Matthew 19:11 But he said to them, "Not everyone can receive this saying, but only those to whom it is given.



Singleness (Remaining Unmarried)

Matthew 19:12 For there are eunuchs who have been so from birth, and there are eunuchs who have been made eunuchs by men, and there are eunuchs who have made themselves eunuchs for the sake of the kingdom of heaven. Let the one who is able to receive this receive it."
